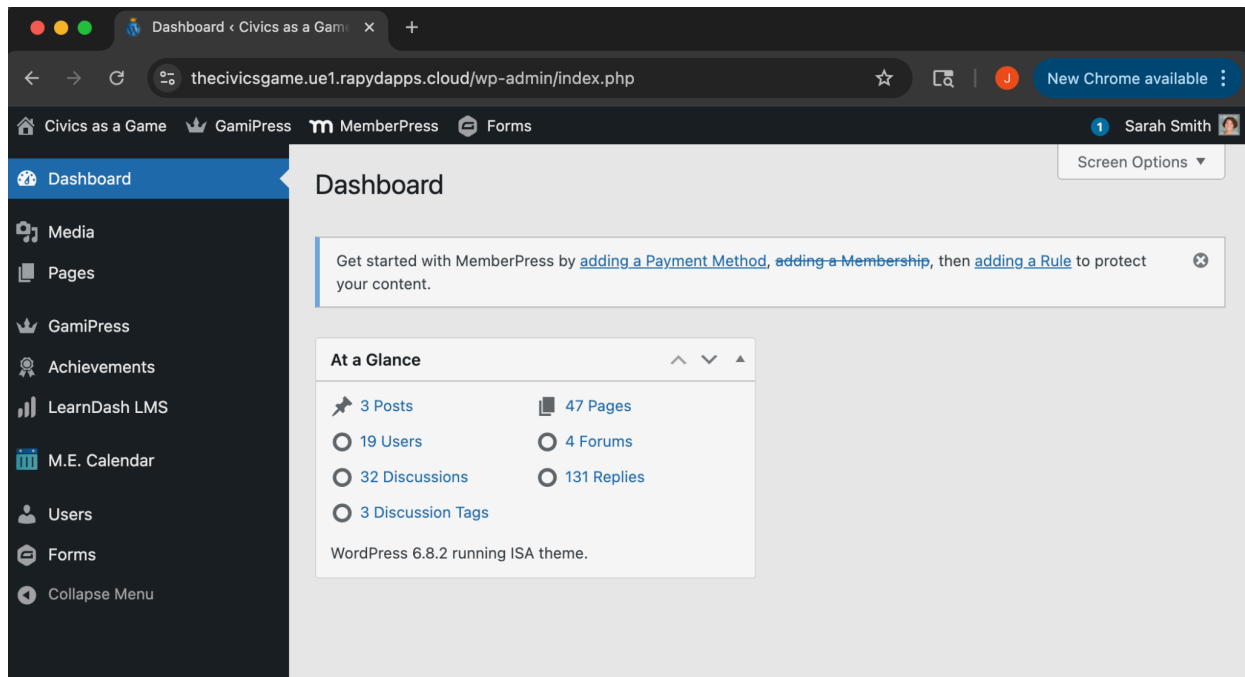

Create Student Account

In normal game play, students are responsible for creating their own accounts.

- During the 2-week sign-up period, accounts are automatically approved, and students can begin play immediately.
- Outside the sign-up period, visitors can create new accounts, but they will not be activated until the Teacher reviews and approves them.

In special cases, Teachers can manually create User Accounts. To do so:

1. On the Civics as a Game homescreen, click the button on the top left that says "Civics as a Game"
2. On the taskbar located at the left hand side of the screen, click "Users".
3. Next click "Add Users:" and begin creating accounts for your students. A username and email is required.
4. Make sure the students have the appropriate roles, such as group leader.

Students can change the password by clicking "forgot my password" when signing in.

Set User Role

To manually set the user's Profile Type (Journalist, Party Leader, etc.):

- Go to **Users > All Users > [user_name]**
- Choose the **Extended Profile** top tab
- From the **Profile Type** section in right sidebar, choose desired profile type.
- Click **Update Profile** button

Teacher's Role in Elections:

- Creates election polls
- Schedules debates
- Co-moderates debates with student Journalists
- Verifies election poll results
- Assigns role upgrade
